



NOTICE OF APPLICATION OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY'S REQUEST TO INCREASE ELECTRIC RATES FOR THE 2020 ENERGY RESOURCE RECOVERY ACCOUNT REVIEW APPLICATION A.21-04-001

On April 1, 2021, Southern California Edison Company (SCE) filed its Energy Resource Recovery Account (ERRA) Review application with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) requesting a total of \$60.772 million. If the CPUC approves this application, SCE would recover this amount in electric rates beginning in 2022.

Why is SCE requesting this rate increase?

Every year, SCE is required to file its ERRA Review application on April 1 for the CPUC's review. In 2020, four authorized SCE memorandum and/or balancing accounts had an undercollection of funds that were necessary to cover costs. As a result, SCE is requesting a net revenue recovery that would increase customers' rates by approximately \$0.50 per month.

How could this affect my monthly electric rates?

If SCE's rate request is approved by the CPUC, the average residential monthly bill using 500 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month would increase by approximately \$0.50 or 0.4% per month, from \$122.59 to \$123.09. The following table shows current rates compared to the proposed rate changes by customer group.

How does the rest of this process work?

This application will be assigned to a CPUC Administrative Law Judge who will consider proposals and evidence presented during the formal hearing process. The Administrative Law Judge will issue a proposed decision that may adopt SCE's application, modify it, or deny it. Any CPUC Commissioner may sponsor an alternate decision with a different outcome. The proposed decision, and any alternate decisions, will be discussed and voted upon by the CPUC Commissioners at a public CPUC Voting Meeting.

Parties to the proceeding are currently reviewing SCE's application, including the Public Advocates Office, which is an independent consumer advocate within the CPUC that represents customers to obtain the lowest possible rate for service consistent with reliable and safe service levels. 





WESTMINSTER — A 44-year-old man pleaded guilty Wednesday and was immediately sentenced to time served in custody and ordered to pay \$2 million in restitution for a \$3 million affinity fraud scheme in Garden Grove.

Lo Van Tran of Fremont was sentenced to 630 days in jail, or time already served since his arrest in May 2019. He was also placed on two years of formal probation.

Tran faces 12 years in prison if he fails to complete probation, his attorney Cameron Talley said.

Before his arrest, Tran paid back \$800,000 and has chipped in another \$100,000 now, Talley said.

"He came forward and told the people he defrauded them," Talley said. "He didn't mean to steal their money. He used their money to start another business and thought he could pay them back."

Tran collected the money from more than 10 investors, most of them Vietnamese, between June 2017 and February 2018, according to Garden Grove Police Department Lt. Carl Whitney.

Tran promised a predetermined return based on the amount invested in his scheme, which involved a company he owned and operated called SmartBuy Outlet Inc., which had two storefronts in Garden Grove, Whitney said.

"The business also operated under the name SavMax Solutions Inc.," Whitney said. "As a side business related to SmartBuy Outlet Inc., Tran claimed to have a partnership with a third-party logistics company known as Zyp Corporation, where he would facilitate the purchase and sales of large amounts of Apple products."

Turns out Zyp Corporation never existed, Whitney said.


"He also fabricated bank and business documents to make his business appear legitimate," Whitney said.

Affinity fraud involves preying upon victims from the same identifiable groups, "such as minorities and professional groups," Whitney explained.

April 15 came early to parts of Santa Ana, Anaheim and Garden Grove. Until now it's been a surprise: "Nobody knew about it."

People ages 16 and older who live in four ZIP codes of Santa Ana, Anaheim and Garden Grove can get a COVID-19 vaccine now – an expanded age guideline that won't apply in much of California until April 15.

Actually, teens and adults from the four predominantly minority, working-class neighborhoods – in Santa Ana's 92701 and 92703 ZIP codes, Anaheim's 92805 and Garden Grove's 92844 – have been eligible to get a shot since Friday, March 26. But few seemed to know about it.

The county did not disseminate the new information and some city officials, as well as the head of Latino Health Access, said they were caught off guard and are only now OC Register April 2, 2021 Page 2 of 3

working to get the word out to the nearly 222,000 people who live in those neighborhoods.

"We didn't know about it," said Santa Ana Mayor Vicente Sarmiento, noting that it was brought up during a press conference on Wednesday, March 31.

Orange County Health Officer, Dr. Clayton Chau referred to expanded eligibility in the four ZIP codes at the end of a press conference when answering a question about whether the county is prepared for a potential new surge of coronavirus.

"You probably didn't hear about it because we didn't want other ZIP code people to freak out because we wanted to make sure we intentionally cover those in the vulnerable ZIP codes first," Chau said.

Sarmiento said he's grateful to Gov. Gavin Newsom for prioritizing hard-hit residents in "health equity ZIP codes." State officials announced that 40% of all vaccine doses would be sent to the most vulnerable neighborhoods, spread among 400 ZIP codes statewide.

But over the past week local officials didn't realize that they could begin inoculating all residents within those ZIP codes.

"Nobody knew about it," said America Bracho, executive director of Latino Health Access in Santa Ana.

"Imagine this, now we have the ZIP codes that are a priority where everyone can be vaccinated. And as of yesterday (April 1,) it opened to everyone older than 50. And on April 15, it will be open to everyone," Bracho said. "Now, we have two weeks of a window for people in these ZIP codes to get a vaccination before everyone is eligible and there are delays.

"We have to be better in taking advantages of those windows," she added.

Latino Health Access has mobilized with mobile vaccination pods and is working with community clinics to alert those who are eligible. Residents who need help in accessing a vaccine appointment can call the Latino Health Access Call Center at 714-805-7838.

In Santa Ana, city officials have sent text messages to residents and added workers to answer a hotline for local residents (714-667-2273) that assists people signing up for a shot.

"We wanted to help residents now eligible to sign up for a vaccine through Othena, which wasn't allowing it online," said Santa Ana spokesman Paul Eakins.

On Friday, April 2 – a week after the eligibility expanded in vulnerable neighborhoods – the county's online vaccine registration system, Othena, added a question to its website: "Do you live in the following ZIP codes: 92701, 92703, 92805, 92844?"

Meanwhile, on Facebook, both Santa Ana and Anaheim posted information about the new eligibility.

Anaheim spokesman Mike Lyster said his city was notified by the county on Friday, but that timing did not present a problem.

"We had already prioritized the 92805 ZIP code," Lyster said. "This was a major focus for us."

Anaheim vaccinates residents at community clinics throughout the city and at two major vaccination sites, Disneyland and the Anaheim COnvention Center.

In Garden Grove, Councilwoman Diedre Thu-Ha Nguyen, whose district includes the 92844 ZIP code, said neither she nor the city manager were aware that everyone in the Vietnamese-majority neighborhood was eligible for a vaccine.

"Information like this should be disseminated right away," said Nguyen, who volunteers once a week at the Christ Cathedral vaccination site.

Authorities break up Southern California grocery theft ring; 2 men arrested

At least two Orange County men have been arrested in connection with a grocery store theft ring, and officials said Thursday that roughly \$1 million worth of the stolen goods were found during a search at a home and a business.

The theft ring involved the people stealing goods from stores all over Southern California, the majority of which were later stored at a Midway City home where at least one of the main suspects lived, said Lt. Brandon Shipwash of the California Highway Patrol's Organized Retail Crime Taskforce.

Some of the goods also were stored at a business that appeared to be an electronics repair shop in Garden Grove, where investigators believe the suspects may have resold some of the products, he said.

Various retail companies, such as Ralphs, had recognized some of the same shoplifting suspects returning to their stores and reached out to the task force in January, according to Shipwash. Investigators then began surveillance of the suspects, along with the Midway City home and Garden Grove business, he said.

Suspects could be seen every day bringing bags of goods to either the home or business when investigators did surveillance, Shipwash said.

"There were people coming in and out constantly with bags of what appeared to be stolen goods," he said. "From the moment they wake up, they'll hit up to eight different stores in different areas throughout the day, bring it back here or meet up with one of the guys from the house."

Four people were in handcuffs as investigators searched one of the units of the large, two-story duplex in the 14500 block of Hunter Lane in Midway City on Thursday morning. CHP officers brought out boxes full of stolen products, such as baby formula, skincare and beer.

Most of the goods were in the home's garage, but Shipwash said one other room in the home was full, in addition to some boxes in the kitchen. It was possible the suspects were also selling the stolen goods out of the home and there was even a "no exchanges, no refunds" sign near the boxes in the kitchen.

"It was like stock rooms, just filled floor to ceiling with this stuff," Shipwash said.

Dennis Au, 57, who lived at the Midway City home, was arrested in connection with the theft ring, in addition to Van Tran, 59, of Garden Grove, CHP Sgt. Jim Kelley said. Each were booked on suspicion of organized retail theft, grand theft and possession of stolen property, he said.

The two other people at the home during the raid were detained for unrelated warrants, Kelley said, but only one person was taken to jail because the probation office rescinded the warrant for the other person.

Shortly after the raid at the home, other CHP investigators raided the business at the strip mall in the 13600 block of Magnolia Street in Garden Grove. No one appeared to be inside the business when investigators first knocked on the storefront's door, but then used a key to enter.

The business had several signs advertising repairs for computers or phones, but electronics could not be seen from the store front. Dozens of bottles of wine were stacked and lined up against one wall of the business, with random objects including an ice chest that could be seen strewn about.

Investigators also brought out large bags of goods after several minutes of taking pictures of the scene.

Oftentimes, people will resell stolen goods on websites such as OfferUp or Craigslist, but Shipwash said it appeared items were also being sold at the store as well. It appeared that people who bought items from the store were aware of the theft ring, he said.

"That's what you'd think and that's what we assume," Shipwash said. "Because you don't see anyone coming in for computer or phone repairs."

Shipwash said the two men arrested were the primary suspects of the operation and, while the other people in the theft ring were identified, the task force would work to determine how involved each individual was to decide how to proceed going forward.

The raid was one of the largest Shipwash said he's seen since the task force formed in November 2019. The team was created with CHP because organized retail crime often travels across jurisdictions and counties, he said, which can make investigations more difficult for smaller, local agencies.

A JADU is a unit no more than 500 feet in size and contained entirely within a single-family residence. A JADU may contain separate or shared sanitation facilities.

At the March 23, 2021 regular meeting of the Garden Grove City Council, the City approved revisions for adoption of Ordinance No. 2919, pertaining to new regulations for ADUs and JADUs.



Cal Cities Public Safety Task Force concludes work Recommendations to go before Public Safety Policy Committee April 15

April 7, 2021

The League of California Cities Public Safety Task Force has wrapped up its work reviewing Cal Cities' public safety policy and guiding principles and forming recommendations to bring to the Public Safety Policy Committee on April 15.

The task force reviewed issues related to minimum qualifications for peace officers, decertification of peace officers, use of force, and addressing mental health and substance abuse populations' needs. Task force members were briefed on the pillars of 21st Century Policing by Cal Cities board member Chris Catren, chief of police for the Redlands Police Department. The California Police Chiefs Association also provided a briefing to task force members.

Recommendations developed by the task force are meant to inform and guide Cal Cities' advocacy on police reform. They will be considered during the April 15 Cal Cities Public Safety Policy Committee meeting before moving on to the full Cal Cities Board of Directors for consideration.

The Cal Cities Board of Directors voted in December 2020 to create the task force to provide feedback and recommendations on public safety policy priorities, Cal Cities policies, recent legislative activity, and proposed legislation.

Cal Cities President Cheryl Viegas Walker appointed to the task force 22 city leaders from across the state with a breadth of experience working on public safety issues.

Cal Cities-sponsored bond agency issues \$35 million in taxexempt bonds for affordable housing in Millbrae

April 7, 2021

New affordable housing in the city of Millbrae will be constructed for lowand very low-income residents with \$35 million in tax-exempt affordable housing bonds issued through the California Statewide Communities Development Authority (CSCDA).

About Gateway at Millbrae Apartments

Gateway at Millbrae Apartments in Millbrae is the new construction of 80 multifamily affordable housing units, which provides the community with studio and one-bedroom units to low- and very low-income residents. All of the units will be reserved for households earning less than 30, 40, 50 and 60 percent of the area median income.

CSCDA and the project sponsor, The Core Companies, partnered with Citibank and Orrick Herrington & Sutcliffe LLP to provide \$35 million in bonds to build the project.

The newly-constructed affordable housing project in the city of Millbrae will ensure that residents have an updated, safe, and affordable community to call home for years to come. The financing for these projects will maintain the affordability of units for low-income tenants for 55 years.

Since its beginning, CSCDA has financed the construction or preservation of nearly 100,000 affordable units throughout California. Despite these efforts, affordable housing for all income levels still remains in short supply.

The League of California Cities' co-sponsorship of CSCDA continues to be a significant benefit for Cal Cities members. CSCDA has issued more than \$63 billion in tax-exempt bonds for projects that provide a public benefit by creating jobs, affordable housing, healthcare, infrastructure, schools, and other fundamental services.

CSCDA is a joint powers authority created in 1988 and is sponsored by Cal Cities and the California State Association of Counties. More than 530 cities, counties, and special districts are program participants in CSCDA, which serves as their conduit issuer and provides access to efficiently financed, locally-approved projects.
